



- Item 17/18: Terry Caldwell and Ian Radley will remain responsible for the information on the new AWTTA website www.awtta.or.au. There is no expected end date

 - The prices of the goods received from Affordable Table Tennis are whole sale prices.

Bas Smeulders proposed the following:

- The pricing of the stock should be transparent and therefore the pricing of the items will be 20% on top of the wholesale price, except when the price of the item becomes more than the website price. In this case the price of the item will be equal to the website price;
- No postage & handling costs will be added;
- A stock count will be done within an interval to be decided by the committee;
- A specified sales description.

A few members of the committee did not approve the above-mentioned proposals, because this would be too difficult and not necessary.

Ian Radley proposed the following motion:

Add 20% to the price on the received invoices, reduce the stock significantly and no tracking process of the sales.

The motion has been accepted by vote: 6 for and 1 against.

Agenda Item 5: Treasurer’s Report

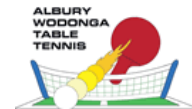
Mover: Manley, Barbara **Seconder:** Radley, Ian

Agenda Item 20: ACC Sponsorship

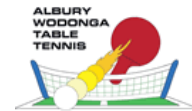

Agenda Item 26: Country Week

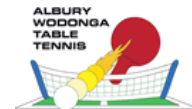

Kerry Bell will investigate with woodworkers if it is possible, and if so, will request an estimate of the costs. Item will be moved to the Action Item List.

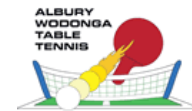
