IDEALS OF THE AWTTA:

What the Albury Wodonga Table Tennis Committee expects of you when you represent AWTTA and/or play fixtures:

- 1. Your primary goal is to have fun playing table tennis.
- 2. Play by the rules.
- 3. Judge yourself by the effort that you put in, not by the result of the game.
- 4. Accept defeat and victory without undue joy or disappointment.
- 5. Acknowledge good play by your opponent.
- 6. Be a good sport, acknowledge edges and double hits.

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:

- 1. Respect your opponent and your fellow players and particularly remember there are other persons and (possibly) children in the stadium no yelling, temper tantrums or swearing while playing.
- 2. Unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated.
- 3. 'Sledging' players, umpires, officials or event organisers is unacceptable. Sledging is defined as a statement or physical behavior intended to denigrate and/or intimidate another person.
- 4. Repeated late arrival for matches is unfair to your team and the opposition.
- 5. DO NOT publicly question an official's judgement and never their honesty.
- 6. Creating a public disturbance or acting in a way that becomes a public nuisance is unacceptable behavior.
- 7. Causing intentional damage to another person or organization's property or equipment will not be tolerated.
- 8. You may not make statements that have the effect of denigrating the team, squad or group that a person represents or to which a person belongs.
- 9. Any form of harassment, sexual or otherwise is unacceptable.

BREACH PROCEDURES:

Any alleged breach of this Code of Conduct will be addressed in accordance with the AWTTA Conduct and Dispute By-Laws (14.2 & 14.3) i.e.

- Referred initially to the Dispute and Conduct Sub-Committee for resolve.
- If no resolve or unacceptable resolve is met, the matter is referred to the AWTTA Committee for ruling.
