Agenda Item 3: Action and Grant Items

#### a. Action items

- 08/25 ABR details updated form has been sent to ATO via registered mail.
  Completed
- 13/25 Card options to replace petty cash new account has been set up with Bendigo Bank and cards issued. Completed
- 21/25 Funding for Event Partnership sponsorship Janet Freer followed up with AlburyCity and the invoice has now been paid. Completed
- 23/25 Keenagers InterClub Event Terry Caldwell provided an overview of preparations for the next event planned for 20-21/3/2026. Terry Caldwell proposed that entry costs be increased to \$35 per day for players, \$30 per day for non-players and \$20 for dinner only and this was accepted by the Committee. Trivia to be arranged for entertainment instead of live music. Catering arrangements are still to be finalized Entry forms will be sent out by Terry Caldwell in coming weeks.
- 25/25 North East Challenge discussion was held about the email received from Rod Armstrong (Yarrawonga TTA) proposing the recommencement of the North East Region Table Tennis Competition. Ashley Harding to respond to the survey. Ian Radley advised that when the North East Region competition declined previously due to lack of interest, the North East Challenge was introduced. Agreed that any plans for the North East Challenge be placed on hold until further notice.
- Annual 24 Evaporative coolers to be serviced early October Terry Caldwell reported that a booking will be made with Cameron Burt for this work to be undertaken October. Leaks in roof to also be checked at the same time.
- Annual 25 Petrol mowers to be serviced in September Terry Caldwell reported that one mower was serviced. Completed
- 26/25 Ride-on mower purchased Terry Caldwell reported that a Cox Stockman ride-on mower has been purchased from Albury Engineering & Mower Service. Completed
- 27/25 Treasurer's role Terry Caldwell reported that no expressions of interest have been received to date. Executive Committee members will undertake required tasks until a replacement is found.
- **28/25 Social Night** Ian Radley indicated that this activity will be held on Friday 7 November from 6.00pm until 9.00pm. Notices and entry form will be available at the Club. Participants to bring finger food to share. Limited to 56 players.



- 29/25 Solar batteries options Ian Radley spoke to preliminary discussions held with Watters Electrical. Estimated cost \$25,000. Availability of grants limited. Second quote to be sought. In principle agreement given by the Committee to proceed with purchasing solar batteries for the Club.
- 30/25 Hall of Fame (Club Legend) proposal lan Radley spoke to the draft proposal circulated to Committee members prior to the meeting. The Sub-Committee (Stuart Davidson, Ian Radley and Ash Harding) proposed that the name be changed to Club Legend rather than Hall of Fame. Noted that it would be preferable for approval (consensus %) requirements by the Committee to be the same as that for Life Member. Committee members to provide any feedback so that this proposal By-Law can be finalised.

#### b. Grant items

• **01/25 AlburyCity (Event Partnership)** – endorsed \$1,000 sponsorship. Funding received 4/9/2025. Acquittal to be completed at end of this year.

## Available grants:

- NSW Infrastructure Grants (Sport & Recreation) noted that another round opens on November 24 and closes 15 December 2025. Grant amounts range from \$50,000 to \$300,000. Terry Caldwell suggested that an application be submitted for the changerooms/toilets stage of the proposed Club development.
- AlburyCity Sport and Recreation Grants no application to be submitted at this stage.
