Agenda Item 3: Action and Grant Items

a. Action items

- **25/25 North East Challenge** – still waiting on contact from Yarrawonga Club.
- **29/25 Solar battery options** – Terry Caldwell commented that the Club intends to apply for another grant to fund the installation of a solar battery – applications open 1 July. Updated letter of support has also been sought from AlburyCity.
- **34/25 Change electricity provider** – pending installation of solar battery and updated electricity prices.
- **36/25 Club Legend nominees** – sub-committee is considering potential nominees. Suggested that an electronic screen be installed to display details of Club Legends, Life Members and other relevant Club information rather than another Honour Board.
- **01/26 Honour Boards updated** – pending corrections to be made by Border Sign Studio.
- **20/26 Repairs to robot control boxes** – Chris Greal advised that he is still working on repairs to the third control box.
- **22/28 Victorian Seniors Festival** – expression of interest has been submitted to Wodonga Council and confirmation received. To be held in October. Completed
- **Annual 28 – Rubbish removal agreement (JJ Richards)** - due for renewal by 31 July 2026. Janet Freer to seek quotes from other suppliers before any agreement is signed.

b. Grant items

- **05/25 AlburyCity Community Infrastructure Fund** – Architect expenses for Club redevelopment project. Pending outcome of application. Draft AlburyCity budget suggests that funding will be unlikely.
- **Grant to fund installation of solar battery** – Terry Caldwell to submit an application when Round 1 of the Game On: Teaming up for climate action program opens on 1 July.

Agenda Item 5: Treasurer's Report

Report for the period ending 31 May 2026 was circulated to Committee members prior to the meeting.

The following points were noted:

- Term deposits were reinvested on 28 May 2026 with varying terms and interest rates to ensure funds are available as required.
- Xero monthly subscription will increase as from July 1.
- The Senior and Junior Tournaments held in May made an overall profit of \$722.38. Numbers were down this year with only 31 Senior players and 45 Junior players registering for the tournaments.
- Albury High School invoiced for April and May and supervisors paid for sessions up until the end of May.

The Club continues to remain in a strong financial position.

Agenda Item 6: General Business

- **Victorian Country Championships results**

The Victorian Country Championships (VCC) were held in Traralgon on June 6-8. It was the 74th VCC and 74 teams participated in Divisions from A1 to E3.

D2 – 5th: Cody Luton (1st Individual), Michelle Bowd, Julie Lindner (Wangaratta player substitute).

D3 – 1st: Geert Mensinga (4th Individual), Sandra Eldridge, Terry Caldwell.

In the evening individual and doubles competitions:

- Max Geering won the Open Men's Singles.
- Levi Geering won the Youth Singles.
- Levi Geering won the Men's Doubles with a Mornington partner.

Congratulations were extended to all members who played in the Championships.

- **Indie School Sessions**

Recent sessions went well. Ian Radley and Bruce Cowan supervised the sessions.

- **Office access**

Emily Bollingmoore raised her concerns about players entering the office. Doors to be kept locked and signs posted. Coordinators and Committee members to enforce as necessary.

- **Club development going forward**

Ian Radley suggested that it may be an appropriate time for the Club to review its focus given that recent funding applications for the toilets and changerooms project have not been successful. Whilst it was still considered important to apply for funding in order to progress this project, it was acknowledged that it is becoming harder to secure grants.

The question was asked: should the Club consider options for undertaking modified projects using own funds, seeking a loan, or other alternatives?

Ian Radley also commented that the external walls of the Clubroom need to be painted, or clad with colourbond or other suitable material, to improve the street appearance of the Club and hopefully attract more members. It was noted that some of the weatherboards were deteriorating and will require maintenance soon.



It was suggested that the Club contact AlburyCity to discuss options for improving the external walls of the Clubroom. Members agreed that any contact should wait until we have been officially notified of the outcome of our current grant application.

- Access to National Veterans equipment

Ian Radley proposed that the Club seeks to purchase additional equipment, such as table tennis tables, court barriers, scoreboards, flooring, etc. once the National Veterans Championships being held in Albury have finished. It is usual practice for equipment to be offered by the supplier at significantly reduced prices after such an event. Ian Radley offered to contact Paul Pinkewich at Table Tennis World to submit an expression of interest on behalf of our Club.

Noted that AWTTA has still not received any official notification from TTA and AlburyCity about this event being held in Albury from 17-24 October.

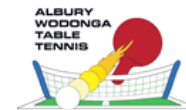
- Other Matters

They are endorsed by TTA to deliver their Sporting Schools program. Requested information about AWTTA to assist with referring students onto their local table tennis club.
- *Sponsorship renewals* – Ian Radley reported that he has commenced discussions with current sponsors inviting them to renew their sponsorship for the next financial year.
